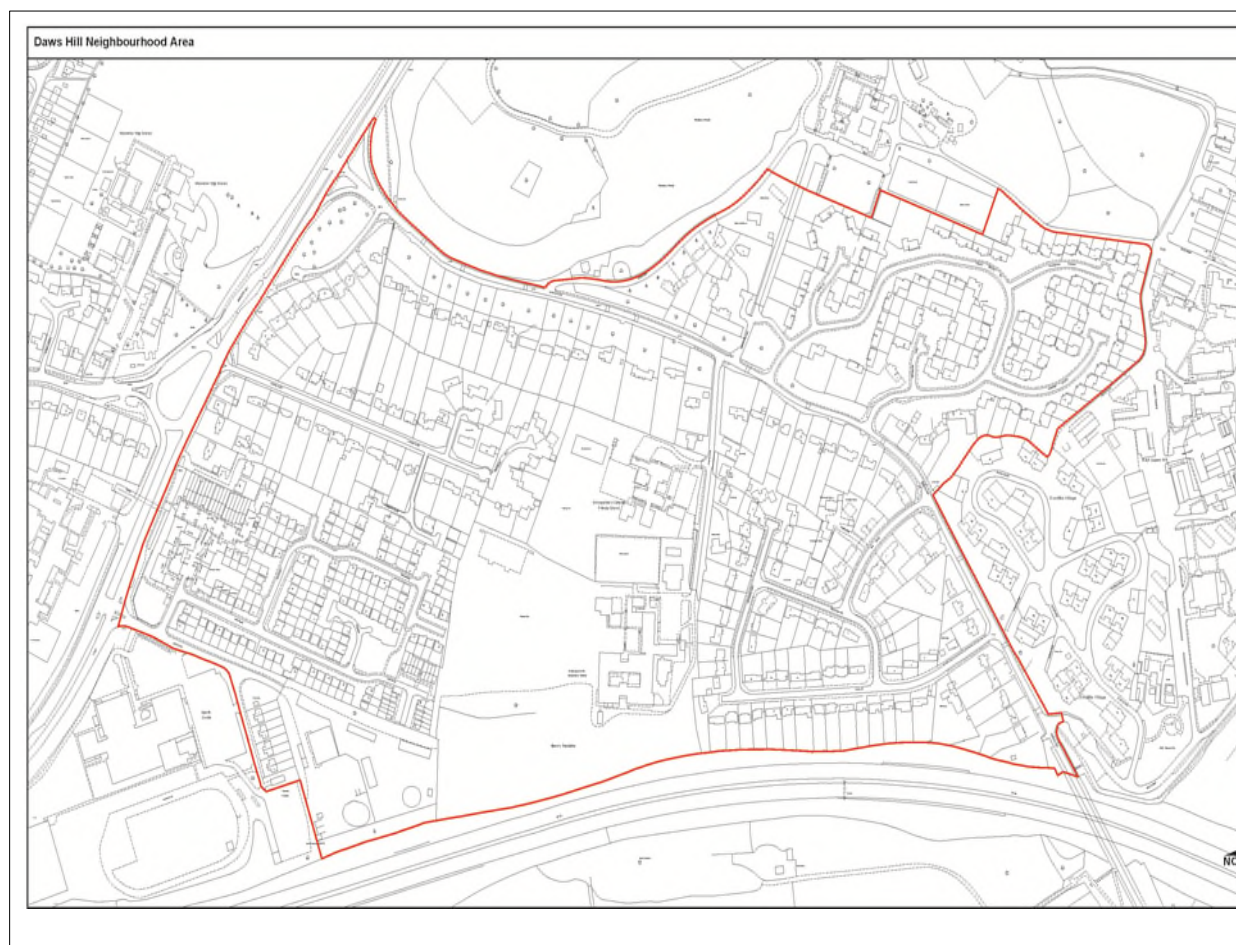


Daws Hill Neighbourhood Forum Preparation of a Neighbourhood Plan

Daws Hill Neighbourhood Forum is in the process of preparing a **Neighbourhood Plan**



for the **Neighbourhood Area** shown in the diagram below.

Under Regulation 14 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, a public consultation must be carried out, lasting for a period of not less than 6 weeks, to enable residents and businesses in the **Neighbourhood Area** to comment on the proposed **Neighbourhood Plan**. Once implemented, the **Neighbourhood Plan** will give these residents and businesses enhanced powers to influence development within the **Neighbourhood Area**.

The period of the Regulation 14 Consultation lasts from **Monday 25 June 2018** until **Sunday 5 August 2018**.

A copy of the proposed **Neighbourhood Plan** is available to read or download on the **Daws Hill Neighbourhood Forum** website – **DHNF.org**. Reference copies of the **Neighbourhood Plan** are available at the public libraries in Chapel Road, Flackwell Heath and High Wycombe, and at the Wycombe District Council Offices.
